The DCM may appoint special events and Ad Hoc committee Chairpersons.

Committee Chairpersons may make motions concerning any subject, but may not vote. (See Service Manual Chapter 7)

Each January, the new incoming DCM:

Updates the list of active groups provided by the Area Registrar

Provides the Area Registrar with a list of District Committee Chairpersons

Forwards all group Change Forms to the Area Registrar and to the General Service Office in New York City. (The DCM may appoint a District Records Secretary to keep current records and submit them to the Area and GSO in a timely manner).

In December of every year the DIP will be reviewed to insure that it reflects all changes voted on during the previous year.

The DCM will receive funding of \$150 for each out of town Assembly, \$300 for both out of state SWRAASA's and State Regional Forums. In state SWRAASA's and Regional Assemblies will be funded the same as Area Assemblies.

Relapse will be considered an automatic resignation by an District Trusted Servant or Committee Chairperson.
